

Note to Our Patients regarding Our Financial and Appointment Policy

INSURANCE:

CDA staff will be happy to bill your insurance carrier; However, your insurance agreement is between you and your insurer- if they fail to pay for any reason, you are responsible for the entire bill.

FINANCIAL:

1. Payment is due at the time of service. We except cash, checks, and several types of credit card including healthcare credit cards offered in house.
2. All co-payments, deductibles and non-covered services must be paid at time of service
3. In case of estranged or divorced parents, the parent accompanying the child to the visit is responsible to pay for services rendered regardless of coverage arrangements. We will gladly provide you with necessary information for reimbursement.
4. If you are experiencing financial difficulties please discuss this with the business office staff. We will gladly work with you to make payment arrangements. Accounts over 90 days may be referred to a collection agency.

APPOINTMENTS:

Try and be prompt for your appointment. If you arrive more the 15 minutes late we may have to reschedule. Since your appointment time is reserved for you, we ask you give us at least a 24-hour notice if you must cancel or reschedule. That way we are able to offer that time to someone else, **Failure to give 24-hour notice will result in a \$25.00 charge to your account.** Failure to cancel two appointments may necessitate the termination of your association with this office

It is our office policy to perform a high standard of care for our patients. It is with this understanding that we place composite restorations instead of amalgams (Metal Fillings.) Some insurance companies may not recognize the added benefits of amalgam over composite, which means that you are responsible for paying the difference of what your insurance company will not cover. The fact that these restorations are mercury-free, bonded to your teeth for strength and esthetically replicate your teeth eliminating the metal look, make these the clear choice for a restorative material, and one that fits our high standard of care.
